Signs in the Heavens

The following is a continuation from December, 2023 newsletter, by Pat Chadwick..

The Comet Nishimura continues to give us signs in the heavens concerning the last days. When I saw that the comet had lost its tail, I mentioned it to Aaron Smith and he sent me this reply, which I'm sharing as I feel it is of importance. God is using many avenues to warn us His coming is neigh at hand.

Aaron comments: What strikes me is this phrase, The Lord showed me He is the center. Then you (Pat Chadwick) indicate that this comet flew around the sun, after cutting Virgo in half and lost its tail. The momentum was slowed but then as it re-emerged on the other side of the sun, it had gained its tail back and momentum as well. So, very literally, after a close encounter with the Sun/Son, the momentum was regained and the tail visible again. He literally confirmed what He gave me (Aaron) a year ago now in physical form (see February, 2023 Women's newsletter).

Aaron continues: *Now, two other points that struck me about this:*

The tail, as I thought about how it lost its tail, it reminded me of a bride and her train or veil. In our custom today, the veil is taken off the bride so the groom can see her fully and then kisses her finally, signifying their union. I believe it is very appropriate that the veil/train was removed on the far side of the Sun/Son so that this piece is hidden from the world. The close union of the church and the bridegroom will be done with no other eyes upon it. It will be for them alone.

Last, the length of the orbit. They have indicated this has an orbit of 430 years. That number struck me significantly tonight as well. Then it hit me. From the time that Abraham left Haran to their deliverance from Egypt, the House of Israel was in bondage or wandering for 430 years.

The question before us today is: if Christ comes as a *Thief in the Night* in 2024 will we be ready?#

How to Increase the Power From the Holy Spirit

- Spend time in praise and worship: And the hour cometh, and now is, when the true worshipers shall worship the Father in spirit and in truth; for the Father seeketh such to worship Him. For unto such hath God promised His Spirit. And they who worship Him, must worship in spirit and in truth John 4:25-26.
- Spend time in prayer and fasting: Draw nigh to God, and He will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, ye sinners; and purify your hearts, ...James 4:8. Much like praise and worship, prayer and fasting draw us closer to the Lord. And being in God's presence increases our faith ... We see the power of prayer and fasting in Matthew 17:20-21 when the disciples were not able to cast demons out of someone.
- Study, study, study the Word: All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness; that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works 2Timothy 3:16-17, Heb. 4:12.
- Desire Spiritual Gifts: Follow after charity, and desire spiritual gifts, but rather that ye may prophesy (1Corinthians 14:1). The Holy Spirit's power manifests in many ways and one of those is through His Gifts. Paul urges us to desire them but makes it clear that we must also pursue love, as well. Our heart-motive needs to

- be love, not a desire for supernatural power. And that love must stem from our relationship with Jesus. Otherwise, what will manifest is found in Matthew 7:32-33.
- Be obedient to His voice: physical obedience to the laws of God brings about spiritual obedience to the laws of God which brings about spiritual growth and power through the Holy Spirit. If ye love me, keep My commandments. And I will pray the Father, and He shall give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth Him not, neither knoweth Him; but ye know Him; for He dwelleth with you and shall be in you John 14:15-17. Jesus was obedient to the Father and was able to perform many miraculous things. Partnering with God will help you to see His will established on earth as it is done in heaven. See also Isaiah 28:10, 2Nephi 12:35-28.
- Grow in faith: if we continue drinking milk, we will remain childish in the things of God. We must be willing to grow and mature in our faith. It's when we are mature that the Lord can entrust us with more. And I, brethren, could not speak unto you as unto spiritual, but as unto carnal, even as unto babes in Christ. I have fed you with milk, and not with meat; for hitherto ye were not able to receive it, neither yet now are ye able. For ye are yet carnal; for whereas there is among you envying, and strife, and divisions, are ye not carnal, and walk as men? 1 Corinthians 3:1-3.
- Spend time with those who function under the Holy Spirit: surrounding yourself with people who are walking in the power of the Holy Spirit will help to cultivate a closeness to the Lord and the way He moves and manifests. Iron sharpeneth iron; so a man sharpeneth the countenance of his friend. Whoso keepeth the fig tree shall eat the fruit thereof; so he that waiteth on his master shall be honored Proverbs 27:17-18. See also 1 Corinthians 6:14, 15:33. Proverbs 13:20-21.

Youth With a Mission (YWAM): to know God and make Him known

YWAM is a global movement of Christians from many cultures, age groups, and Christian traditions dedicated to serving Jesus throughout the world. Founded in 1960 by Loren and Darlene Cunningham, YWAM currently operates in more than 1100 locations in over 180 countries, with a full-time staff of over 18,000 people. In addition, they send out 25,000 short-term missionaries each year. YWAM's many ministries fit into three main categories: *evangelism*, *training*, and *mercy ministry*. Through these ministries.

Evangelism: the many creative tools used to present the gospel include—drama, music, videos, websites, and sports camps. Reaching teenagers, elderly refugees and the unreached people in the world. They start churches in many places where there is no church at all.

Training: through training programs they aim to better equip Christians to grow in their relationship with God and serving others by utilizing agriculture and healthcare, business development and biblical counseling. These include Discipleship training schools, University of the Nations, and King's Kids International.

Mercy ministry is the hands and feet of making God known at YWAM. They help meet some of the practical and physical needs of more than a million people annually. They have reached street children in South America, aided in the recovery of drug addicts in north America and Western Europe. They feed and house refugees and women in need in Africa and Asia and have helped start small businesses in countries like Thailand.

Little Slav was sitting in a box crying quietly. His eyes pushed tears that could not be stopped.



The box had a label written with a black marker, **BOX FOR THE BROKEN** as it turned out, the only toy that Slav was able to bring with him from Kyiv had broken, so the boy concluded, *It is broken now, just as I am. I now belong in this box for the broken.*

When the war with Russia broke out, Slav's mother fled to Europe with her children and the few belongings they could carry. Every day she watches as her children talk about their home and their dad, who is now defending their country. They attend school in this neighboring country, where they stick together with the other Ukrainian refugee kids. They are hungry to talk with those who share their heartache.

This war has broken us all, says the mom, clasping her delicate fingers to her chest. We have been shattered by this war. We long for the healing hands of the **One** who can wipe our tears, who knows our pain, and who wants to make us whole again.

Her family is a small representation of the millions of Ukrainian families, especially the children, affected by this war. By April, 2023, two-thirds of Ukraine's 7.5 million children have been displaced according to the Ukrainian Commissioner for Human Rights, and more than 228,000 Ukrainian children were reported to have been deported to Russian territory. YWAM Pub. 2024 page 20.

The following is an invitation for us to pray for the City of Independence, the Restoration, and Zion.

- ⇒ Pray for families, parents, fathers, fatherless, mothers, motherless, orphans, homeless, and children of all ages.
- ⇒ Pray for peace in homes, in streets, in schools, in businesses.
- ⇒ Pray for children, the next generations understanding & lack of understanding of purpose.
- ⇒ Pray for the doctors, lawyers, agents of every kind to be honest and righteous in judgment.
- ⇒ Pray for all denominational/non-denominational church sites, the CoC, Restoration Congregations and all factions in our area.
- ⇒ Pray for any government influences in that area. Sites, water, electrical plants.
- ⇒ For satan's hordes and armies to be run out, destroyed in the lives and areas covered by prayer.
- ⇒ Pray for the light to override the dark. The evil to be destroyed by the good.
- ⇒ For brotherly kindness and acts of kindness.
- ⇒ For generosity, honesty and gratitude to overshadow thievery, lies and entitlement spirits.
- ⇒ Pray for healing of spiritual, emotional, physical, mental wounds, those present and from the past.
- ⇒ Pray that God's hand will be seen and recognized, evident in that area through mercy or judgment.
- ⇒ Pray that God would prepare all for their role in the *Army of God*. That they will rise up and overtake their areas of influence under the direction of the Holy Spirit.
- ⇒ Pray for the wall of fire to encircle our area.
- ⇒ Pray for all leaders, officials, teachers—anyone

- who works at a school, influencers, First Responders, community workers, social workers.
- ⇒ Pray for every kind of business: stores, public and private schools, banks, hospitals, offices, restaurants, bars, tattoo, vaping, hotels, parks, Planned Parenthood, event centers, stadiums.
- ⇒ For leaders, righteous leaders and removal of evil leaders.
- ⇒ Binding the strongman and men, and strong ones (Matthew 12:38-39).
- ⇒ Pray against the evil influences of evil music, words, drugs, alcohol, even pharmaceutical addictions
- ⇒ Pray that all that has been built on lies will crumble, that only truth will prevail.
- ⇒ Pray for the hounds of Heaven to search out the lost and deceived and turn them back to Christ.
- ⇒ Pray for groups that are trying to bring light in their area that their efforts may be magnified for Christ.
- ⇒ Pray for the manifestations of miracles, healings, deliverances, and blessings.
- ⇒ Pray for the people's and the area's role in Zion.
- ⇒ Speak God's Word, prophecies and promises over your area of stewardship.
- ⇒ Declare that this area is no longer open to any who fight against Zion.
- ⇒ Pray God would send His Angelic Armies into the homes, streets of your area.
- ⇒ Pray that the believers would come together and declare this City as the *City of Our God*.

These are so important that we should be praying unceasingly.
