God Initiates All Spiritual Growth

Our Lord's timing but we are to ask, seek, and knock. This is one of the major points of the Heavenly Messenger to Gary and what he has repeatedly mentioned.

Part Three

Understanding the Compassion of Christ

Some of the major points brought were:

- Gary shared the **incident last class** of being taken by the H.M. to Jerusalem during Passover and the sacrificing done. He said there was so much blood that not all of it was taken by the priests into the temple but was poured over the wall into the river, which ran red with blood for a long time. He then shared the type/shadow of the Spirit of God will flow through out the world like a flood...We are on the verge of these prophecies coming about. Unless you are prepared for the harvest it's only a mental exercise. Are we prepared?
- One thing we all have in common **Brokenness.**
- **Faith** = is the power of creation to make the invisible become real (visible).
- Jesus in us: nothing was made without Jesus. There is faith in Jesus, not that we have faith all the time but there is faith resonate in the Messiah. It is the faith of Jesus, the faith that resonates in Jesus that we need, we need Jesus in us. The goal is not to be like Jesus but to have Jesus live inside of us. This is a clear and precious faith that He offers to us when we make covenant. Because of what Jesus has done for us He has opportunity to live inside of us.

- God initiates all spiritual growth: we know this but, the question is **when?** When do you recognize it? There are certain pivotal points where we recognize God is doing something in a way that changes everything.
- **God doesn't just want us**—He wants everything of us, in such a way that we will release everything that we think we have so He can replace it with something a thousand times better.
- What is our identity? Is it to have Jesus in us? Dependence on Jesus?
- Be a beacon of hope: mercy, justice and judgment have to be understood in the days ahead because what the world needs is compassion, led by God's Spirit to meet the needs that will take place in the world. God has set everything in motion for you and I to be instruments of compassion. Don't just sit there and watch it happen. If you want to be a beacon of hope you must understand the nature between mercy, justice and judgment.
- Mercy, Justice, Judgment: a thorough understanding of how this trio works can be gleaned from the following scriptures: Alma chapters 16-19 esp. 19:79-80, 15:55 and 77-78, 16:215-217, 19:105, 9:55, 16:135, 19:81-114. This trio of spiritual power is tied together. They are not individual entities, they bond to each other.

What has God not done for us because of the hardness of our hearts? Repentance is aligning ourselves with His Word, it's based on God's word, not what we feel. Repentance activates mercy, Jesus stands between us and Justice and God sees us and judges us through Jesus.

Mercy, Justice, Judgment continued:

If we want to have mercy extended to us we need to learn to repent. When we truly repent from our heart it opens a portal for all the value and power of mercy to be extended to us. Mercy is not an emotional value that God has. Those that repent can claim mercy.

The divine pattern is that when we repent it opens up His mercy which has a tremendous value to us, otherwise we are subject to the justice that is around us. Repentance is the key to mercy.

Christ has all mercy and when He sees we are repentant He can move in our life in a way that is not just to be forgiven.

When mercy is activated judgment and justice have to line up together again. When someone finds themselves needing to be cleansed and the Lord hears it and responds to it, justice opens its value up to that person. Mercy will not over-power justice.

Our righteousness is in Christ, allow Jesus to stand in such a way as to release mercy to us.

- **Spiritual Warfare**—we have no idea what goes on spiritually all around us and in us.
- God's Spirit, the Holy Spirit, is in everything. Why do we pray God send us your Spirit? We should be praying: help us perceive where God is, acknowledging the reality of what He is doing, what is not seen—aka faith. Ask the Holy Spirit to be the driving force of your life.

A few of my own thoughts:

• Earl Curry in his <u>Study of Spirituality</u> says: *The Holy Spirit is the enabler of our wills.* • I believe that repentance is a gift because true repentance brings about mercy, Jesus' mercy and we are made whole on this side of the vale so we don't carry those sins on to the other side and have to deal with them then. See Alma 16:232. The same spirit we leave this life having aka character, attitude, spiritual wounds—we take with us to the other side.
