Four Statements of Agreement Following our 2024 Kirtland Experience, as Agreed Upon 11-2-24

Item 1: We recognize our great need to be one with Jesus Christ.

Are You Living the Measure of Your Creation?

Therefore, it (the earth) must needs be sanctified from all unrighteousness, that it may be prepared for the celestial glory; for after it hath filled the measure of it's creation, it shall be crowned with glory, even with the presence of God the Father;.. verily I say unto you, The earth abideth the law of a celestial kingdom, for it filleth the measure of it's creation, and trangresseth not the law. Wherefore, it shall be sanctified; (Dc 85:4c & 6a-b).

If the earth is living out it's full measure of it's calling, we most certainly are to also, as well. This *measure of our creation* or *calling* is the subject I have felt impressed to dedicate this newsletter to.

The concept of a **calling** is something many of us want to know we are doing, but how do you know if you are living out the specific calling in your life? Patriarchal Blessings, given in the past, have often shed light on our gifts and talents and at times specifically spoken to a calling of the individual receiving the blessing.

Joy in the Work

When you are living in your calling, there is joy found in the work, even if happiness is not present at the moment. There is a difference between *joy* and *happiness*,

though they are often considered synonyms.

- Joy is a quiet assurance of something or someone, despite circumstances or feelings.
- * Happiness is a feeling that can shift or change on a whim; move with the feeling or sentiment of the day or levels of stress.

When you are living in your calling, there is joy found in the work, this is because your task is not rooted in emotion, but instead stability that even in the hard times, there is a fullness that things are as they should be. It is better to root ourselves in joy rather than feeling.

It is Challenging

A significant aspect of living out a calling is finding fulfillment and excitement even in the face of challenges. This is not to say a calling must be a challenge, nor is it to say that it never is. Instead, even when challenges arise, there is a sustained desire to face the challenge head-on. These challenges will prove fruitful in helping us grow, will fuel new ideas or methods of approaching issues, and keep things moving forward into the future.

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For the gifts and callings of God are without repentance — God doesn't renege on His word or gifts or decrees or promises.

The Work is Never Done

Living out a calling confirms the work is never done. A calling versus a temporary project goes on and endures. A project is for a season and typically has a time period of beginning and ending. A calling grows and changes with time.

You Are Inspired

Passion and inspiration are a huge necessity when it comes to a calling. There is a sense of curiosity and intrigue in continuing on the path of discovery within a calling. What might happen if you keep working? What could be the outcome of going down this path? Where are places of potential growth and learning? Inspiration will take you far in your calling.

A Sense of Assurance

When one lives out their calling, there is a sense of knowing confirmed within. This is often an unspoken feeling, a deep peace not contingent on outward circumstances. This is why it is important to be in tune with your inner self when pursuing a calling and asking God is vital. This sense of assurance is something no man can buy, contrive, or invent; it is something freely given from within.

...that every man may improve upon his talent, that every man may gain other talents; yea, even an hundredfold, to be cast into the Lord's storehouse, to become the common property of the whole church, every man seeking the interest of his neighbor, and doing all things with an eye single to the glory of God. DC81:4f-g

Confirmation From God

A true calling comes from God, so it is important to connect with God when investigating where you are called to and for what reason. Consider those in the Scriptures who were called into specific missions or quests for a calling. These callings often came directly from God, through verbal command, revelation, dream, or an invitation of the Lord. Jeremiah 33:3 reminds us to-

"Call to Me and I will answer you and tell you great and unsearchable things you do not know."

It is the delight of the Lord to reveal to us what He has for us to accomplish in life. Seek Him to truly see and know what it is that He has to bear fruit through your life.

Fruit

The fruit that is produced from a calling will prove indicative of the plant, the plant being us. Matthew 7:17-20 explains,

... Therefore, by their fruits you will know them."

The fruit from your calling will be directly influenced by what you sow, plant, and water. This is not to say that drought or storm may arise, but there will be evidence even in difficulties.

The fruit of your calling can be produced sevenfold from what is planted when you invite the Lord within it, but it falls on us to invite the Him to abide in your calling.

Your Calling is NOT Your Profession

As was pointed out by Dan Hood recently: Being a musician is not my calling. What happens if I'm in an accident and loose my voice? Or have brain damage and cannot write lyrics? My calling is —"Man is that he might have joy, rejoice, pray without ceasing that our joy might be full"—as this is God's will for you (Dan Hood, 9-22-24).

How you live out the why behind your creation is such a large part of the short lives we live. God has a very specific plan that you are invited into. Tolkien spoke of how as human beings; We are invited to sub-Creators (Co-Users of Gods creative powers) as we are made in the image of the Creator God Himself. Co-creator status can be seen and fulfilled in how we live out our callings. You will know you are living out your calling by the fruit that is born, the sense of assurance within your heart, and confirmation that God Himself will offer you. If you are unsure you are living out your calling—read your Patriarchal Blessing if you do not have one ask the Lord.

Romans 12:2 ...that ye may prove what that good and acceptable and perfect will of God is.

Why it's Important to Have a Knowledge That the Course of Life we Pursue is the Will of God

This knowledge supplies an important place in revealed religion; for it was by reason of it that the ancients were enabled to endure An actual knowledge to any person that the course of life which he pursues is according to the will of God, is essentially necessary to enable him to have that confidence in God, ...it was this that enabled the

ancient saints to endure all their afflictions and persecutions, and to take joyfully the spoiling of their goods, knowing (not believing merely) that they had a more enduring substance Heb.10:34. (LoF 6:2c -3c).

They **knew** they were doing the will of God; therefore, they were absolutely surrendering to the will of God. Having this knowledge allows one to receive the truth in love of it and submit themselves to be guided and directed by His will, and drive them to such extremities that nothing short of an actual knowledge of their being the favorites of heaven, and of their having embraced that order of things which God has established for the redemption of man, will enable them to exercise that confidence in Him necessary for them to overcome the world, and obtain that crown of glory which is laid up for them that fear God (LoF 6:4).

Dying to Self

By William Law with Commentary by Andrew Murray.

This book combines the works of William Law who

was a 16th century priest in the Church of England and Andrew Murray a missionary in South Africa and a prolific writer in the 1800s. It has only 157 pages and is published by Olahuski Books in 2021.

The authors discuss what self is and what dying to self really means. In <u>Dying to Self</u> the point is made that one real hindrance to life endowed with the Holy Spirit is *self* aka the *natural man*. It also discusses our Father's desire to have us with Him in a state of unseparated goodness and happiness brought about by dying to self. Jesus Christ showed this dying to self. The last part of the book discusses how dying to self may be accomplished.

As with all of the Andrew Murray books I've read this one is deep in philosophy and understanding, a book worthy of study.#

White, given at Gudgell Park, April 1941

Study my law instead of the literature of the world. You idle your time away reading magazines, fiction, which study leads you nowhere. But in those things, I have given you as the God of Heaven, saith the Lord today, I have planted the words of life, truth ...vital forces which will make you alive in the Spirit of God, as you know it not.

Men whom I have entrusted with the sacred responsibility of leading My people, oft times have had their powers sidetracked into thing not of my choosing...both they and the people have stumbled time and again, and today my work is almost at a standstill so far as progress is concerned.

I will wait no longer. I will come out of My hiding place. I will shake the things that have no foundation and they shall stumble and fall. I will choose men and women strong and faithful, and who will study, and though few in number they shall know that I am God and able to succor. I will lead them by my unfailing hand for the accomplishment of my purpose, saith the Lord, for my arm is outstretched over you, for I am waiting the day I may send my Son to you in the Temple.

Then great things will take place. The world will be warned for the last time, then the sons of Levi will I send forth with mighty power to bind up the law and seal up the testimony for the last time. Those entrusted with this responsibility will be girded with instruments of my power, and many will return with many sheaves.#
