Human Trafficking

Human trafficking is never an easy topic to discuss, but we can no longer avoid the information available, even though it may be painful to consume. The following details the horrors of human trafficking and provide insight into the ever-increasing online presence that modern day traffickers are utilizing to groom and recruit victims.

Psalm 10:17-18 says—You, Lord, hear the desire of the afflicted; you encourage them, and you listen to their cry, defending the fatherless and the oppressed, so that mere earthly mortals will never again strike terror.

This article is intended to bring light to the darkness by uncovering the facts of human trafficking and how it is weaving it's way into every city across the US.A. and every country across the globe. The reality is that the human trafficking crisis is far too large for us to ignore. But now that we know, this should awaken us to the need for Zionic living now..

During lockdowns (ie. Covid), online recruitment increased 22% while other forms of recruitment tactics decreased (ie. foster care by 70%, strip clubs by 46% and schools by 38%). In 2020, there was a 125% increase in Facebook and a 95% increase in Instagram recruitments over the previous year.

The proportion of victims recruited by family members increased by 21% in 2019 to 31% in 2020—a 47% increase. In 2020, 42% of all victims reported being brought into trafficking by their own family.

Absolute Surrender

Continued from last months newsletter. One of the characteristics of surrendering our wills to the Lord and His infinite wisdom is

Patience

which is enduring without complaint.

God is a God of Patience (Rm. 15:5). Patience brings freedom from fear (Luke 21:13). The present state of man requires patience (Heb. 10:36). Patience is necessary. The manifold inconveniences of impatience is a strong motivation (John 4, Ps. 56:3&4, Alma 1:36 and 14:111).

Examples of patience are found in Hebrews 12:2, 6:12, and, of course, Job—what did he do in the face of adversity? He worshipped!

To be patient we must resolve that all our trials will end in triumph (James 5:7-8, Rm. 2:7, Mos. 11:23).

Patience is the very nature and essence of God in us (Rm. 2:4, Mos. 2:9, Alma 7:40).

Patience has nothing to do with *self will* or *bravery* or *fortitude*. It comes into practice by Divine will, God's truth and scriptural teaching.

What provocations did Joseph receive from his brothers and yet he didn't mention the crime, but was eager to announce the pardon.

David says in Ps.109:3-4 They compassed me about; they spoke against me also, with works of hatred, and fought against me without a cause. And not withstanding my love, they are my adversaries, yet I will continue to pray for them.

Ps 35:11-13 says that Afflictions (pain, distress, grief...) come to exercise our patience not only in consequence of the Divine blessing, but by the natural operation of things. By saying *it was so trying, who could help it*, this justifies impatience when God meant it to build patience.

Some Promises of Patience

are found in James 5:7-8, 1:2-4, 1Pet 2:20, Gal. 6:9, Heb. 10:23, 6:12, 10:36, Matt. 24:13, and Rm. 5:13-14.

Keep your eyes upon Jesus,

Look full in His wonderful face.

And the things of earth will grow strangely dim,

in the light of His glory and grace.

Absolute Surrender Keep My Commandments

This message is throughout all three books of scriptures.

In the Kirtland message of Sept. 2022 we are admonished:

I say unto you, **listen to Me**. There are two stewardships that will ensure success if you will do them.

One—as the five wise virgins did in the parable of the last days, Gather and sanctify your oil, before the cry at midnight. Prepare yourself through scripture, prayer, fasting, and humble service. You must take the Holy spirit as a guide in all things that you do in your life.

And two—be willing to remove all barriers and hindrances to the achievement of Zion. You must become one. This would include the groups and associations you have formed, and the responsibilities that you carry.

Promises

Obedience to the Father *reaps many blessings*, a few of these promises are listed below. All scripture references are KJV:

- O that there were such an heart in them, that they would fear Me, and **keep all my commandments** always, *that it might be well with them, and with their children forever!* (Deut. 5:29).
- Therefore whosoever heareth these sayings of mine, and doeth them, I will liken him unto a wise man, which built his house upon a rock; and the rain descended, and the floods came, and the winds blew, and beat upon that house; and it fell not; for it was founded upon a rock (Matt.7:24-25).
- If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in His love (John 15:19).
- And whatsoever we ask, we receive of Him, because we keep His commandments, and do those things that are pleasing in His sight (1John 3:22).
- For whosoever shall do the will of My Father

- which is in heaven, the same is my brother, and sister, and mother (Matt. 12:50).
- And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof; but **he that doeth the will of God** *abideth forever* (1Johm 2:17).
- And being made perfect, He became the author of *eternal salvation* unto all them that **obey Him**; (Heb. 5:9).
- Verily, Verily, I say unto you, **If a man keep My saying**, he shall never see death (John 8:51).
- ...the resurrection of all the prophets and all those that have believed in their words, or all those that have **kept the commandments of God**, these *shall come forth in the first resurrection*...(Mos.8:56).
- ...What have you against being baptized in the name of the Lord as a witness before Him that ye have entered into a covenant with Him that ye will serve Him and **keep His commandments**, that He may pour out His Spirit more abundantly upon you? (Mos.9:41).

There are really only two basic or foundational commandments, they are

⇒ To love the Lord thy God wih all thy heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy mind, and with all they strength.

And the other is to

 \Rightarrow Love thy neighbor as ourself.

There is none other commandment greater than these (Mark 12:35-36).

Live by all that you know, and the way you should go will I show you each step of the way; be my people today, work and study and pray. For you must be endowed for this day. Consecrate now your all, and give heed to my call to obey all my laws and commands...(Shirley Mason hymn 358).#

It's not rocket science! It's pretty plain and simple, absolute surrender. What is absolute surrender? "...when I give a commandment to any of the sons of men, to do a work unto my name, and those sons of men go with all their might, and with all they have, to perform that work, and cease not their diligence,.. (DC107:15a).#

1 in 6 children ages 9 to 12 have had romantic or sexual conversations with an online-only contact. 1 in 8 kids ages 9 to 12 have shared a nude image with an online-only connection.

In a study analyzing the trading of Child Sexual Abuse Material (SCAM), data found that cases with prepubescent victims—roughly ages 3-12 are more likely to be traded than infant/toddler or pubescent material. Findings show that SCAM images depicting younger children and more egregious content—such as beastiality or sadism are more likely to involve familial offenders and more likely to be actively traded. Roughly 59% of all SCAM created of infants and toddlers being traded involved a familial relationship. Infant and toddler SCAM is the most likely to be actively traded. YouTube is the number one platform where minors have shared their own Self-Generated-SCAM at 78%.

In 2016, an estimated 40.3 million people were victims of modern slavery. From 2011-2016, 89 million people experienced some form of modern slavery for periods of time ranging from a few days to five years or beyond. Within the US, 83% of victims in confirmed sex-trafficking incidents were identified as U.S. citizens. One out of every 130 women worldwide is a victim of human trafficking. Children represent one to 4 victims of human trafficking world wide.

54% of minors believe online grooming is a common experience for kids their age. 1 in 7 minors are asked for nudes by a stranger online daily or weekly.

40% of minors have reported they felt uncomfortable online because they were asked for personal information. 1/3 of all minors have become uncomfortable after experiencing someone online try to become close with them too quickly or contacting them too often. Even so, 23% of minors reported staying in contact with someone they only

know online even after they made them feel uncomfortable. Only 6% of 9 to 17 year olds turned to a trusted adult-parent-caregiver after being sent a nude by someone they thought was an adult.

Human trafficking continues to grow at alarming rates as traffickers begin to increase online grooming tactics. It's important for caregivers to be aware of the necessity for online safety. Minors are growing numb to sharing nudes, connecting with strangers, and not reporting uncomfortable circumstances online. As caregivers, it is imperative that we not only know what apps and games are being used, but that we are actively involved in the lives of those we care for and provide a safe place where our children can come when they make mistakes to receive help and support.

The following are apps and games used by minors, mentioned in several studies conducted by Thorn pertaining to online grooming, self-generated child sexual abuse material, and responding to online threats. Not all of these are inherently bad, but caregivers should be invested in their child's online life.

Amino, Among Us, Bumble, Byte, Call of Duty, Discord, Facebook, Fortnite, Google Hangouts/ Meet, Grand Theft Auto, Grindr, Houseparty, Instagram, Kik Live, Marco Polo, Messenger, Minecraft, Monkey, Nintendo Switch, OnlyFans, Pinterest, Reddit, Roblox, Signal, Slack, Slither.io, Snapchat, Tagged, Telegram, TikTok, Tinder, Triller, Tumbir, Twitch, Twitter, VSCO, WhatsApp, Whisper, WickrMe, Wink, Wishbone, YouNow, and YouTube.

Below are some suggestions for upholding our community—our stewardship in prayer (all scripture references are KJV):

Lift up praise and worship over the city

- Extol the Lord, O Jerusalem; praise your God, Zion. He strengthens the bars of your gates and blesses your people within you Ps.(147:12-13).
- ◆ Declare His Lordship in your community (2K19:19, Ps. 50:23).
- Read psalms of praise to displace any voices of darkness (Ps. 33,35, 65 and 67).

- Declare your home and community to be a dwelling place for God's presence.
- Celebrate the light of His presence which brings strength and favor (Ps. 89:15-17).
- Praise Him for His presence which disarms the enemy (Ps. 31:20, Ex. 33:14).
- Thank God for His presence which prevents any deception or falsehood from taking hold (Ps. 101:7).
- Pray that the hearts of leaders would be drawn together by a oneness of spirit (Eph.4:16, Gal.3:26-28).
- Pray that doctrinal differences would give way to demonstrating the power of the gospel (2Chron.30:12, 1 Cor.1:10).
- Pray that a unified voice would arise from the city, reflecting the Father's heart and will (Rm. 15:5-6).
- Pray that believers would be drawn together in the power of covenant community (Acts 18:9 -10).
- Pray that communications of the enemy would be confused and canceled (Jere.20:11-12, Ps.55:9-10).
- Counter negative words or curses spoken with the promises of God. (Ps.109:26-31, 2Cor.10:2-6).
- Declare that the light of truth will dispel any darkness and expose the lies. (Ps.36:9).
- Pray for boldness to declare the truth of the gospel (Acts 4:29-31, Phil. 1:14).
- Declare the favor of God on those who preach and teach the word of God (Acts 17:16-17, 32).
- ◆ Thank God for His delivering power in defeating all His enemies 1John 4:4).

As we continue to uphold our stewardship let's be even more diligent in our prayers as circumstances and situations increase all around us, remembering that with God, All things are possible for He truly is the God of Possibilities.#
